Terms of reference

Curriculum and Pupil issues

- 1) To receive reports on curriculum provision and assessment including Special Educational Needs provision in accordance with the Special Educational Needs Code of Practice.
- 2) To review and monitor the school's Curriculum and pupil welfare policies including:
Religious Education,
Sex and Relationships Education
Drugs Education
Safeguarding
Behaviour management and anti-bullying
Assessment records and reporting
Complaints
Educational visits
Home School Agreement
and to ensure that the policies contribute to achieving Every Child Matters outcomes.
- 3) To formulate and review a Curriculum Policy statement
- 4) To agree annually targets for pupil attainment exclusions and attendance.
- 5) To receive reports on the provision for and the attainment and welfare of vulnerable children and other groups of pupils with reference to local and national benchmark information.
- 6) To receive reports from curriculum link governors.
- 7) To contribute towards an Accessibility Plan as required by the Disability Discrimination Act.
- 8) To monitor and review the school's curriculum contribution to its Disability, Gender and Race Equality schemes.
- 9) To monitor how the school listens to the Voice of the Child.

Parents and Community issues

- 1) To oversee the development and maintenance of relationships with parents/carers, the community and other stakeholders and to ensure that these contribute to Community Cohesion.
- 2) To monitor parental/community involvement in the school and to make recommendations about the development of future links.
- 3) To review and make recommendations in liaison with the Headteacher on the production of any school prospectus, or on information to be published on the school website.
- 4) To promote and monitor the support and involvement of business and industry in the life of the school.
- 5) To monitor plans for the development of Extended Schools activities.

Membership

The membership of this Committee shall include the Head Teacher, the Safeguarding Governor and four other Governors.

The quorum for the Committee shall be three Governors
