

Exam Results Summary 2015 - 2016

Students at Seven Hills School have the opportunity to take a range of accredited courses including Entry Level qualifications, Asdan and AQA Unit Awards. Additionally cross curricular awards including the Lord Mayors Award and the Duke of Edinburgh Award are taken by students in the lower and upper school.

Due to collaborative working with All Saints, our co-located partners, it was possible for one of our students to attain a GCSE English Language qualification.

Accreditation is centered on upper school students from Y9 to Post 16; however some of our more able students begin Entry Level qualifications for English and Maths in the lower school.

Highlights for this year:

- 18 students achieved Entry Level 2 or 3 in Art – the moderator for the art course praised the portfolio work of the students and up graded some of them based on presentation of their work.
- 33 Y7/8 students achieved the Lord Mayors Award and met the Lord Mayor to receive certificates and badges.
- 9 Y10/11 students achieved the Bronze award from the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.
- Y11/10 results were very high this year with six students gaining Entry Level 3 in both English and Maths.
- 18 Post 16 students gained between one and three Asdan modules from the Towards Independence programme.
- 125 students across the school gained 437 AQA Unit Awards across a range of subjects and challenges.
- 12 Y10/11 students passed a range of units towards Entry Level qualification in Personal & Social Education
